Residential Summer Sewer Credit

Sewer charges are based on the number of gallons of water used, under the assumption that water used in your home goes out through the sewer system.

The Town of Menasha Utility District Commission understands that residential customers might use additional water during the summer months for outdoor purposes which can result in higher consumption of water, some of which does not enter the sewer system. The Commission has taken action to apply summer sewer credits for two quarters as follows:

The charges for sewer in the two summer quarters will be calculated by determining the highest winter quarter consumption and multiplying it by 133%. This will result in a maximum number of gallons to be used for sewer billing for the two summer quarters.

If there is no history available, the calculation would be based on the district's average of 17,000 gallons.

If the actual consumption is less than the calculated consumption, the resident will be billed based upon actual consumption. No additional credits will be given since credits will be given for two quarters.
