MINUTES

Mike Scheibe moved and Veronica Kasperek seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINEES

Chairman Koeppe discussed the new landfill location and again stated that he is pursuing additional members.

Jessica Hansen introduced herself and explained her role at Winnebago County. She then provided more information on the transitioning to the new landfill in Brown County. She also explained that the leaves that we take to Winnebago County are placed in a digester and not in the landfill. She also discussed composting and other efforts by the County to encourage recycling.

OLD BUSINESS

Chairman Koeppe stated that we have collected enough film so that we will receive two more benches. The film recycling effort continues to be a successful program.

NEW BUSINESS

George Dearborn explained that most garden plots have been rented and letters have been sent out to confirm the rentals. He said that he will follow up on the previous renters that have not responded and then contact the individuals that are on the waiting list.

George Dearborn again explained that more committee assistance is needed to monitor the gardens. Chairman Koeppe is working on a letter to gardeners on this issue.

It was noted that the next electronic recycling event will be held at the end of April of this year. The Christmas light collection has concluded this year with substantial success.

A motion was made by Ms. Kasperek and seconded by Mr. Scheibe to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
