The applicant Jeremy Balthazor is proposing to combine his three commercial lots into 1 for convenience and future development. The property is currently zoned B-2 Community Business District. The northern most lot has a home and garage on it and the remaining lots are used for parking. A map showing the current property and the proposed CSM are attached.


Staff Recommendation
