MINUTES

Michael Scheibe moved and Tracy Romzek seconded the motion to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2022 Sustainability Committee meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESSES

Chairman Koeppe stated that 3 applications of interest have been received for the Sustainability Committee and the deadline for those interested in being on the committee is Friday, June 3, 2022.

OLD BUSINESS

Chairman Koeppe stated that we have collected approximately 120 lbs. of plastic film in May. He also said the Fox-Wolf Watershed Alliance clean up effectively removed more than 8,000 lbs. of trash.

Dan Dieck explained that all garden plots have been rented and our garden liaison, Deb Swiertz reported a leaking hose at one of the Wittmann Park watering stations. The Parks Department was going to take a look at it to determine the problem. Chairman Koeppe reported that a new poster has

been created for the October Electronics Recycling event indicating that smoke detectors, thermostats and thermometers are not accepted and light bulbs and batteries need to be removed.
