Rachel Youngquist, Winnebago County Board of Supervisors – 1333 Laurie Drive

Ms. Youngquist stated on September 21, 2021 the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors named the new Fox Crossing dog park after longtime Supervisor and previous Chairman, Jerry Finch. Supervisor Finch advocated for a dog park on the north side of the county for many years. Ms. Youngquist feels as though this was well deserved.

b) <u>210927-2</u> <u>2021 Budget Amendments to Provide Funds for Water and Wastewater Capital</u> <u>Projects, the West American Drive Median Improvement & Concrete Panel Replacement</u> <u>Project, the Midway Road Pedestrian Crossing Project, Police Chief Recruitment, and</u> <u>Stormwater Payment Adjustments</u>

MOTION: Trustee Van Dyke, seconded by Trustee McNamee to approve as submitted. Director Piergrossi stated while there are a lot of items in this amendment, most were already approved by the Board at previous meetings. The Midway Road pedestrian crossing project for \$10,000 is a joint project with the City of Menasha. A second amendment is for \$10,000 to aid the Police and Fire Commission in recruiting a new Police Chief. The funds for the \$25,000 stormwater payment are not needed this year, therefore it is being requested to delay this advancement to allow the funds to be used in the future. There is also an amendment for the American Drive Median improvements as the contract went over budget.

There are two projects happening due to the new high school being built. This budget amendment is for two capital items including the extension of CTH II water and sewer and a deep sewer main near the high school. President Youngquist and Village Manager Sturgell clarified that while the sewer project is related to the school, there is more benefit and cost savings for the Village by completing the project now rather than in the future. On roll call vote, Motion carried 7-0.
