FINAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE JACOBSEN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village of Fox Crossing Board of Trustees, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, did pass a Preliminary Resolution (#240311-3) on the 11th day of March, 2024, declaring its intention to exercise special assessment powers under WI Statutes, Chapter 66.0703 for the installation of curb and gutter, storm sewer main, storm sewer laterals, and a limited number of water and sanitary sewer laterals, to certain properties located along Jacobsen Road, and did publish the required statutory Notice of Public Hearing on Special Assessments in the *Post-Crescent*, and did further mail a copy of said Notice of Public Hearing to affected property owners within the required statutory time. A Preliminary Engineer's Report is available for viewing and inspection within regular business hours in the Village Clerk's office; and

WHEREAS, the specially benefited property affected by the installation of new curb and gutter, storm sewer mains, storm sewer laterals, and a limited number of water and sanitary sewer laterals, is the area along Jacobsen Road from Irish Road to County Highway CB (see map in attached Engineer's Report); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fox Crossing Board of Trustees, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, did hold a Public Hearing at the Fox Crossing Municipal Complex, 2000 Municipal Drive, Neenah, Winnebago County, Wisconsin on the 8th day of April, 2024 at 6:00 p.m., pursuant to the published Notice of Public Hearing and a mailing of said Notice to property owners, for the purpose of informing and hearing all interested persons concerning the Preliminary Resolution and the Report of the Village Engineer on the proposed improvements (along Jacobsen Road from Irish Road to County Highway CB) and did hear all persons desiring audience at said hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Fox Crossing, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, as follows:

- 1.) That the Engineer's Report drafted by McMahon Associates, Inc. pertaining to the project and all plans and specifications are hereby approved and adopted.
- 2.) That the Village of Fox Crossing Board of Trustees are aware that the work for the improvements shall be carried out in accordance with the Engineer's Report.
- 3.) That payment of said improvements be made by assessing the cost to abutting property owners in accordance with the schedule of assessments as determined in the Engineer's Report as authorized under Chapter 66.0703, WI Statutes 2019-2020 as amended in the exercise of the Village of Fox Crossing police powers.
- 4.) That all costs to area property owners shown in the Engineer's Report are true and correct, have been determined on a reasonable basis, and are hereby confirmed. That all improvements for which assessments are being made are determined to specially benefit the real estate in the area being assessed by the Village of Fox Crossing Board of Trustees.
- 5.) That the Village of Fox Crossing negotiated costs for this project, and that the Village of Fox Crossing is further directed to carry out the work for said improvements, all as aforementioned.

- 6.) That the assessment shall be paid in cash, in full, or in annual installments (based on the table below) with all deferred payments to bear interest at the rate of 2% above the rate of the Village borrowing, which will be charged per annum on the unpaid balance. That the balance of the assessments and interest to date will be paid if and when the benefited real estate is sold. A minimum \$250 principal payment must be made in a year.

\$500 - \$4,999	Five (5) years
\$5,000 - \$19,999	Ten (10) years
\$20,000 - greater	Fifteen (15) years

- 7.) The Village Clerk of the Village of Fox Crossing is directed to publish the resolution as a Class One (1) Notice in the *Post-Crescent*, Appleton, Wisconsin.
- 8.) The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this Final Resolution and a statement of the final assessment to each property owner affected whose name appears on the assessment roll and whose post office address is known or can, with reasonable diligence, be ascertained. Assessments may be revised whereas the assessment may be less; however, the assessments shall not exceed the Engineer's Report pursuant to Chapter 66, WI Statutes.

9. A draft of the covenants or restrictions, if proposed must be provided.
10. A Development Agreement shall be executed prior to any lot sales.
11. The temporary cul-de-sac shall be more clearly defined showing that lots 40 and 41 are not developable until Americus Street is extended east.
12. A clarification that there is a thirty (30) foot setback for the homes fronting Jacobsen Road.
13. Police Department reviews speed limit along Jacobsen Road from Clayton Avenue to County Highway CB.

RE: Current Update on Jacobsen Prairie Preliminary Plat

Overview

The Planning Commission reviewed the 58 lot single-family subdivision on March 20, 2024. They voted 6 to 1 recommend approval to the Village Board with a few conditions. On March 25, the Village Board then voted to table action on this preliminary plat to address some design concerns for the lots fronting on Jacobsen Road. Staff and the Village President then met with the developer to address these concerns.

The majority of the conditions originally included in the recommendation to the Planning Commission have been addressed so only the following conditions remain.

1. Receipt of the recommendation of the Park Commission on either parkland dedication or fees in lieu of dedication. (The Park and Recreation Director is recommending the collection of fees.)
2. A draft of the covenants or restrictions, if proposed must be provided. (We are currently not aware of any proposed covenants.)
3. A Development Agreement shall be executed prior to any lot sales. (A draft agreement has been initiated.)

In addition to these conditions, staff is still working on buy-in calculations for the Church Pond and a method of transmission to that pond. If that will not work then the developer will have install some form of onsite detention.

Staff Recommendation

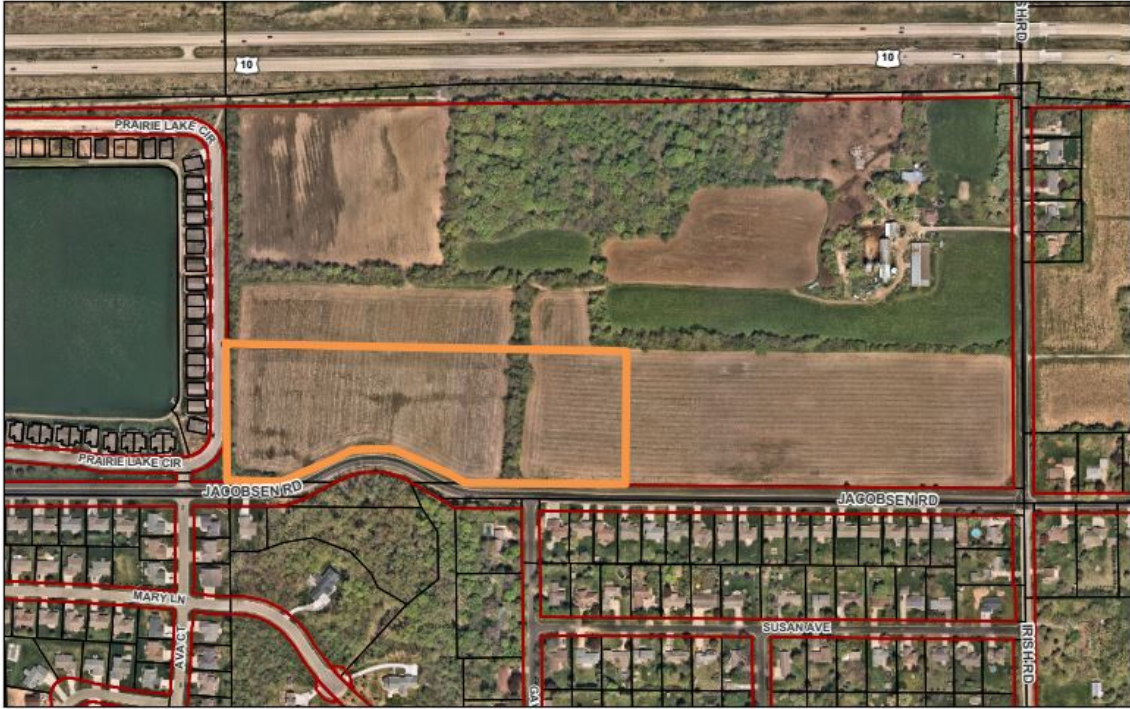
I continue to recommend approval of this preliminary plat. There are many examples of residential driveways accessing collector streets. For example, there are sections of East Shady Lane, Irish Road, Lake Street, Cold Spring Road and other portions of Jacobsen Road that have multiple driveway accesses.

I understand the concerns and do recommend a speed reduction on this road, but I contend that this development will be no less safe than any other collector roads in the Village and other areas of the region.

We desperately need additional single-family lots in the Village. We are down to the last few residential lots in the Village. This development is also designed to be "affordable". Affordability is now considered a home selling for less than \$350,000. The average price of a new home in Fox Crossing is now over \$400,000 with many selling for well over \$500,000.

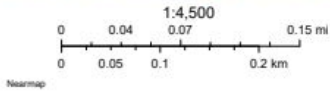
Location Map

Fox Crossing Public Web Map



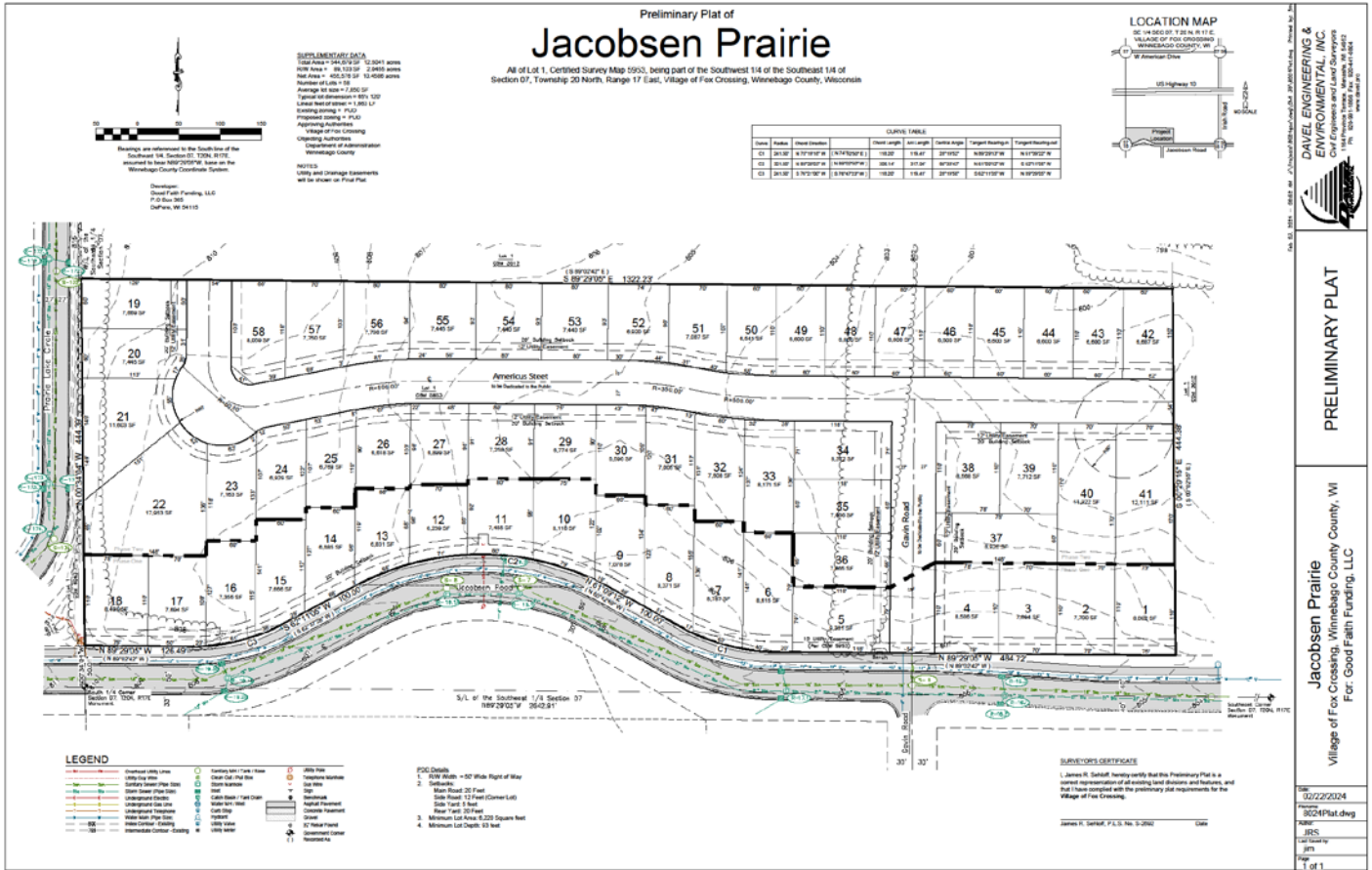
