WHEREAS, the total expenditures for the 2023 Water Utility budget are \$13,534,886, which includes debt principal and capital payments of \$8,937,549; and

WHEREAS, the total expenditures for the 2023 Wastewater Utility budget are \$11,218,614, which includes debt principal and capital payments of \$7,456,392; and

WHEREAS, the total expenditures for the 2023 Stormwater Utility budget are \$8,855,447, which includes debt principal and capital payments of \$7,310,377.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Fox Crossing Board of Trustees hereby sets the Village budget for all fiscal year 2023 funds with \$34,720,462 in expenditures and \$33,646,774 in revenues as per Attachment 'A'.
