### Frequently asked questions:

Please refer to the Village of Fox Crossing Solid Waste Policy for detailed information regarding automated collection of garbage and recyclables.

#### What is solid waste?

Solid waste refers to garbage, recyclables, yard waste and leaves, bulk items and items banned from Wisconsin landfills.

Items banned from Wisconsin landfills per State Statute include recyclables, yard waste, leaves, grass clippings, aluminum containers, corrugated paper and container board, glass containers, magazines, newspapers, office paper, plastic containers #1 and #2, steel containers, waste tires, electronics, and mixed beverage containers that are primarily made of steel and aluminum. These items must be disposed of properly.

### When can I put my carts out for collection?

Carts shall be placed at the end of your driveway between 3:00 p.m. the day before your scheduled collection day and **BEFORE** 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. If it is put out late you may have to wait until the next week for collection. Carts placed the night before collection is recommended.

### How long can my carts stay at the curbside?

All carts shall be removed by 8:00 a.m. on the day following collection.

### How do I place my carts for collection?

Place the cart with the arrow on the lid pointing toward the street. Do not place the cart within three (3) feet of any object (five (5) feet would be ideal) and do not park any vehicles in front of the cart. If possible, please place the garbage cart on one side of the driveway and the recycling cart on the other side, but make sure your mailbox is accessible. Do not place your cart(s) on the street.

### How much weight will my cart hold?

DO NOT exceed the following weights:

96 gallon cart - 150 lbs. 64 gallon cart - 100 lbs. 48 gallon cart - 75 lbs.

### What if my items don't fit in the cart or I have more garbage than my cart will hold?

We encourage residents to hold their overflow garbage until the next week's collection whenever possible. For overflow refuse weighing less than 45 pounds, you must affix a garbage overflow tag to the bag or item for curbside collection. *Overflow garbage tags may be purchased for \$2.00 each at the Municipal Complex in the Finance Department during business hours*. For large items over 45 pounds, you must make special arrangements with Harter's for disposal.

### How do I dispose of large/bulky items?

The following items are considered special collection items and you must make arrangements for disposal. Items include but are not limited to: appliances with refrigerants, appliances without refrigerants, microwave ovens, mattresses and box springs, hide-a-beds, sofas, chairs, carpeting, tires, etc.

We encourage you to call or visit the websites of Harter's Fox Valley Disposal, Winnebago County (landfill), local salvage and recycling dealers to compare pricing and services. Charges may apply.

### Can I put my name or address on my carts?

The carts are Village of Fox Crossing property and must be left at the residence. Each cart has a unique serial number which has been assigned to your residence. If you would like to mark your carts with your name or address, we suggest using masking tape (or other non-permanent tape) on which to write your identifying information. You can then affix it to the underside (inside) of the cart lid. **DO NOT** use any permanent methods to label your cart.

### What if I want to exchange my cart(s) for a different size?

A cart exchange fee will be incurred for each cart exchanged. Carts must be cleaned out (with soap and water) on the inside prior to the cart exchange. Dirty carts will not be exchanged. Please contact the Street Department if interested in exchanging your garbage and/or recycling cart; based upon cart availability.

### How do I dispose of expired/unwanted medications?

Expired or unwanted human and pet medications in the form of pills, capsules, ointments, liquids, sprays, drops, creams, inhalers, or any other drug no longer needed for its intended purpose, can be properly disposed of at the medication drop box located in the lobby of the Village of Fox Crossing Police Department, 2000 Municipal Drive, Neenah. The medication drop box is available Monday through Friday 8:00am-4:30pm. Both prescription and over-the-counter medications will be accepted.

### Please take care of your carts! Examples of negligent or abusive use of your garbage/recycling carts include, but are not limited to:

- Exposure to solvents, petrochemicals, paints, acids, or other chemicals that damage the plastic or metal parts
- Cuts or scores from any source
- Improper use of cart
- Extraordinary impacts such as being hit by a vehicle
- Burns, scorches, melting, any damage from excessive heat (be sure coals and ashes are completely extinguished and bagged before placing in the garbage cart)

#### **ATTENTION!**

Burning of garbage and recyclable materials is prohibited.

### RECYLCING 101:

All acceptable recyclable materials shall be clean and kept free of contaminants such as food or product residue, oil or grease, or other non-recyclable materials (including but not limited to, household hazardous waste, medical waste, and agricultural chemicals).

Place recyclables loose in your recycling cart – NO PLASTIC BAGS!



### PLEASE RECYCLE:

- <u>Plastic-</u> All Food, Beverage & Household bottles, Jars & Jugs, Dairy Containers & Lids, Deli, Bakery & Produce Container & Lids
- Metal- Aluminum Bottles & Cans, Steel Tin & Bi-metal Cans
- <u>Paper-</u> Newspaper & Inserts, Junk Mail, Catalogs, Office & School Paper, Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons, Phonebooks, Magazines & books with cover, Pizza Boxes
  - Card Board- Break boxes down to flat them prior to putting them in your recycling cart
- Glass- Food and Beverage Bottles & Jars



### DO <u>NOT</u> RECYCLE:

- Aluminum- Pans or Foil
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Chemical Containers
- Glass- Window Panes, Mirrors, China, Kitchen Glassware, Ceramics, Etc.
- Metals- Large/Bulky Scrap Metal Items
- <u>Paper-</u> bathroom tissue, facial tissue, diapers, paper towel, paper napkins, tissue paper, gift wrap.
  - Shredded Paper <u>CANNOT</u> be places in your recycling cart
- Plastic Bags- DO NOT use or dispose of any plastic bags (e.g. grocery store bags or blue recycling bags), in your recycling cart! If there are plastic bags found in your recycling cart, your recyclables will not be collected. Plastic bags are not part of the curbside collection of recyclable material, but they can be dropped off at local retail stores that provide a collection box specifically for plastic bag recycling.
- Plastic Containers- Plastic Wrap or film, Motor Oil Bottles. Styrofoam

## What do I do with items that are not picked up as part of my curbside collection?

- Grass Clippings We recommend leaving them on your lawn, because they return nutrients to your soil. You can transport your grass clippings to the Winnebago County Landfill in Oshkosh for disposal. Please visit the county's website for hours of operation and fees. Grass clippings are NOT accepted at the Village of Fox Crossing Tree & Brush Drop-Off Center.
- <u>Automotive</u> fuel additives, starter fluid, transmission fluid, brake fluid and motor oil.
   (Uncontaminated, used motor oil can be disposed of in the *municipal complex waste oil tank*. You must take your empty containers with you).
- Electronics- banned from Wisconsin landfills and incinerators as of Sept. 1, 2010, include: televisions, computers (desktop, laptop, netbook, and tablet computers), printers, computer monitors, computer keyboards, mice, speakers, external hard drives, flash drives, DVD players, VCRs, DVRs, fax machines and cell phones. These items can be recycled at the Winnebago County Recycling Facility, Office Depot, Best Buy, and Paper Valley Recycling Center also recycle electronics. Please call these local businesses for more information on their recycling programs.
- Paint- Latex paint-once the paint is dry, put the cover back on a dispose of it in the trash (paint can be dried out by allowing it to air dry out by adding sand, kitty litter or latex paint hardener. Oil and lead base paint can be treated as Hazardous Waste

### **Household Hazardous Waste:**

Can be taken to the Winnebago County Recycling Facility Acceptable Items:

<u>Automotive-</u> fuel additives, transmission, break and starter fluids
<u>Cleaners-</u> drain, oven and household; turpentine, solvents, varnish/stain, pool chemicals, polishes, and aerosol sprays
<u>Lawn/Garden-</u> herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, week killer, and

poisons.

<u>Misc.-</u> Household batteries, oil & lead based paint, grease & rust solvents, paint thinners/strippers, adhesives/driveway sealer, wood preservatives, spray paint, mercury.

### Yard Waste, Chipping, Leaf Pick Up

### Yard Waste

### Chipping

Harter's will pick up yard waste bi-weekly coincided with your regular garbage collection day during the weeks indicated by "Yard Waste" on the current Garbage & Recycling Calendar.

### What is Yard Waste?

Leaves, bundled twigs and sticks, roots or shrubs with intact balls, clean woody vegetative material and garden debris in a biodegradable paper bags or containers with lifting handles >30 gallons

Fox Crossing curbside pick up will coincide with your regular garbage collection day, during the weeks indicated by "Chipping" on the current Garbage & Recycling Calendar.

### What is Chipping?

Tree and brush material that are in a single row pile with all "cut ends" toward the road. Piles shall not exceed 5ft. in height' branches cannot exceed 6inch in dinameter

Grass Clipping or Mulch are NOT collected



### **Loose Leaf Program**

The "Loose Leaf Fall Collection Program" is collected on selected weeks in the fall using village equipment and village staff.

In all curb & gutter areas of the village, residents must place loose leaves (no bags) onto the terrace area, along the curb line, within 8' of the back of curb for leaves to be picked up. There is no height restrictions on the height of the leaf piles.

We encourage village residence to put their leaves out sooner than 6AM and more than 48 hours prior to their scheduled pick-up and throughout the program

### Remember the burning of leaves is no longer permitted!!!

### Village of Fox Crossing 2025 Tree & Brush Chipping Programs and Policy

### **Chipping Program**

**Spring Program**: Starts the week of April 14<sup>th</sup> and extends for (4) weeks.

<u>Summer Program</u>: *Requested Pick-Up Service Only*. One week per month. First full week in the months June, July, August, September. Ending September 5, 2025.

Fall Program: Stars the week of September 29th and extends for two (2) weeks ending Friday October 10th

<u>Drop Off Site</u>: Opens April 14<sup>th</sup> and will remain open until November 21<sup>st</sup> (weather permitting) <u>Christmas Tree Collection:</u> Week of January 20<sup>th</sup> on your garbage day (collected by Harter's)

### **Curbside Policy**

Starting in 2025 the curb side Summer Chipping Program will now be a by request service only. This is an effort to make Village operations more efficient during these programs. Residents will be required to fill out a form to get on a pickup list on the Village's website by 11:59PM the Thursday prior to the chipping week. If you are having difficulties with the online form you may call 920-720-7110 for assistance. **IF YOU DO NOT FILL OUT A FORM, YOUR BRUSH WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.** You can find the form on this link:

- 1. Curbside collection is available to Village of Fox Crossing residents and will not be picked up if they are located on private property or if they are in a neighbor's yard
- 2. Residents who hire/contract with a professional service to cut down large amounts of trees or brush shall have the professional service remove that material that was cut by them.
- 3. The chipping routes will coincide with your regular garbage collection day, during the weeks indicated by "Chipping" on the current Garbage & Recycling Calendar
- 4. Per Village Code, tree branches & brush must be placed at the curbside no earlier than 48 hours prior to and no later than 6:00AM the day of your regular garbage collection day unless an extension has been requested to and granted by the Street Superintendent or Director of Public Works.
- 5. All branches & brush will be neatly and loosely placed off along the shoulder of the road (not tied or bundled) with the 'cut' end of the branches facing the roadway. Branches & brush piles shall be neatly stacked in a single row only, no higher than five (5') ft in height.
- 6. Brush & Branches shall be a minimum of 3 feet in length and shall not exceed 6 inches in diameter. If brush and branches are less than 3 feet they will need to be set out as yard waste for Harters to collect. The longer the branch is, the easier and safer it is for our crews to handle. However, the branch shall not exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- 7. If Village crews can work ahead of the normal garbage day schedule, they will return to the same area the following day.

- 8. In the event Village crews cannot complete the collection route on your scheduled day, branches & brush chipping will continue the next business day until all routes are completed.
- 9. Any violation of the Tree and Brush Policy will be tagged for such violation and will not be collected until the violation is corrected.
- 10. If you anticipate having a high quantity of branches/brush out for pick up, please contact the Street Department or fill out the form online. This helps with planning and allowing crews to operate efficiently. You may receive an "Over Size Pile" Tag. This just means that we will be back at a later time to pick-up. Please leave the pile out with the tag on it.
- 11. In the event you somehow miss your scheduled collection or if you have storm damage, branches and brush may be taken to the Tree & Brush Drop-Off Center just off Municipal Drive or to the Winnebago County Landfill in Oshkosh.
- 12. The Village of Fox Crossing will collect tree & brush material at condominium complexes and/or on private roads if the condominium association or owners of the private road provides the Street Superintendent with a declaration or assurances whereby easements are granted to operate on the private road for the collection of garbage & recycling removal.

  The Street Superintendent, however, reserves the right to designate the collection area if the layout of the private street which prevents the proper maneuvering of the tree & brush chipping and collection equipment.
- 13. <u>Village Storm Policy</u>: In the event of a storm, the decision for a storm pick up will be determined by the Street Superintendent and/or the Director of Public Works. A special storm pick up is determined on a storm by storm basis by evaluating the severity and widespread extent of the damage throughout the Village. We will only pick up the areas that were affected. This information will be posted on the Village website. If you have a lot of storm damage in your area you may use the online request form or call our office. However, approval for pickup will be at the discretion of the Street Superintendent and/or Director of Public Works and will depend on crew availability. If no special pick up is provided, please follow the regular curbside and tree & brush drop-off center policies.

### **2025 Tree and Brush Drop-Off Center Policy**

Located at 2000 Municipal Dr. by the Village Municipal Complex off E.Shady Ln. Drop-off Center Hours:

### Monday-Sunday 6:00AM-6:00PM

- 1. The drop-off center opens the first day of the spring chipping program on **April 14**<sup>th</sup> and closes on **November 21**<sup>st</sup> weather permitting.
- 2. Make sure your load is secured before travelling to the drop-off center.
- 3. The drop-off center is open **only to Village of Fox Crossing residents.**
- 4. Contracted or professional services may NOT use the drop-off center.
- 5. The drop-off center will only accept any size tree branches, brush, stumps (no more than 50 lbs.) and detached roots with intact root balls. No wreaths are allowed.
- 6. This is not a yard waste drop-off site!! NO dumping of yard waste, which includes leaves, grass clippings, garden debris, tree/shrub clippings, twigs & sticks, dirt, wooden lumber, wood chips, wood shavings, or any garbage or recycling items
- 7. NO biodegradable paper bags or plastic bags filled with yard waste will be allowed or to be emptied out at the drop-off center. This also includes emptying of containers as well. This is considered yard waste and can be placed out for curbside pick-up. Please see your garbage/recycling calendar for yard waste collection.
- 8. Wood chips will be available to Village of Fox Crossing residents, while supplies last. Residents are required to do their own loading.
- 9. The drop-off center is being video monitored by security cameras.
- 10. Any violation of the Tree & Brush Drop-Off Center Policy will be enforced. Which results in citation being issued for violation of Village of Fox Crossing Municipal Code Chapter 372-11, is subject to forfeiture set forth in chapter A450, fine and penalties, resulting in a citation plus court cost.
