Kris Koepp called the meeting to order at 5:25 pm

MINUTES

Thomas Willecke moved, and Michael Scheibe seconded the motion to approve the minutes of the April 2, 2025, Sustainability Committee meeting.

Motion carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

Kris Koepp informed the committee that the last portion of the street light conversion project was finished in November at a cost of \$16,000. The village has now changed at least half if not $\frac{3}{4}$ of all streetlights saving a significant amount of money over time. He also mentioned that the Fox-Wolf watershed clean up event took place recently which volunteers removed 8,500 lbs. of trash.

OLD BUSINESS

Dan Dieck updated the committee on the community gardens and said all garden plots have been filled. Kris Koepp mentioned that some changes and updates were made to the sustainability section of the website and committee members can suggest changes.

NEW BUSINESS

Kris Koepp reviewed the Certificate of Recycling from the April 26th event showing that 16,066 lbs. electronics were collected. He mentioned that a grand total of 552,534 lbs. has been collected since the event began in 2010. He said we will evaluate the electronics recycling after the October event and decide on whether to continue again next year.
