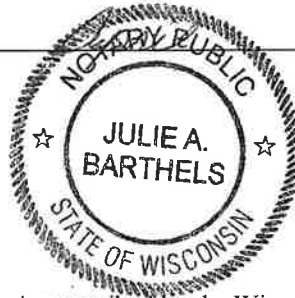

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A recount be conducted of all the votes cast for the office of Winnebago County Board of Supervisor, District 29, at the Spring Election held on April 7, 2026, in the Town of Clayton - Wards 1, 2, 3 & 7 and Village of Fox Crossing - Wards 1 & 2.
2. The board of canvassers convene at 8:30 a.m. on April 17, 2026, at the Winnebago County David W. Albrecht Administration Building, 112 Otter Avenue, Oshkosh, 4th Floor Training Center, to begin the recount.
3. The recount be completed by the board of canvassers immediately.
4. The clerk transmits a certified canvass report of the result of the recount and a copy of the minutes of the recount proceedings to the Wisconsin Elections Commission immediately after the completion of the recount.
