OLD BUSINESS

Dan Dieck gave a community gardens update; all garden plots in Schildt Park and Wittmann have been filled. Kris Koepp informed the committee that Schildt Park will be closed sometime in July for the rest of this year for construction. Dan will communicate with the Schildt Park gardeners at an appropriate time regarding the paving of the driveway and parking area near the gardens in Schildt Park as part of the redevelopment plan for the park. There was a discussion regarding creating a decal/sticker to go on the lids of recycling bins; the three (3) items that are the biggest concerns that should not be thrown into recycling containers are batteries, plastic bags and tangles, with shredded paper being a fourth concern. Kris Koepp reminded the committee of the upcoming Electronics Recycling Event on April 18th. He provided a flyer for duplication to be distributed at the E. Recycling Event.
