Present at the meeting: John Swenson, Doug Greif, Jim Gregory, Bill Wernimont, and Bob Masiak.

Bob Masiak called the meeting to order at 5:05 PM.

A motion was made by John Swenson and seconded by Bill Wernimont to go into closed session pursuant to Chapter 19.85(c)(1) of the Wisconsin State Statutes. The motion passed 4-0. The purpose of the closed session was to interview a prospective patrol officer candidate.

A motion was made by John Swenson and seconded by Jim Gregory to return to open session. The motion passed 5-0.

Minutes from Prior Meetings: Minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved from meetings on 2/10/2026 and 2/25/2026.

Chief's Reports:

- **Fire:**

- Continue to work on the 5-year accreditation process. The risk assessment was presented to the Town Board and was approved. The accreditation team is reviewing the application. Expect a accreditation team visit in May or June.
- Plan to hire ten paid on-call recruits over the next month or two.
- Pursuing a new rescue truck. Lead time is 3 – 5 years.
- Sound system is being upgraded at the stations
- The Emergency Operation Center (EOC) is operational

- **Police**

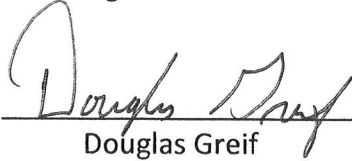
- The two new patrol officers are doing well. Isaiah Coblentz has begun his training at the academy. Dani Joe is undergoing shift training.
- Noah Wallace will graduate in the 2nd week of May.
- Planning to ask the Village Board to approve a 2nd school service officer position.

- Exploring options for new police department building. Looked at the vacant Essity building but is larger than needed and would require renovations.
- The Department issued a statement after a dog was shot in the park by an officer. The dog was attacking another dog and the dog's owners.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 7th at 5:00 PM.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Doug Greif and seconded by Bill Wernimont. The motion passed 5-0 and the meeting ended at 6:10 PM.
