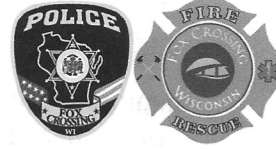

Open Session Minutes from July 7, 2026

Present at the meeting: John Swenson, Doug Greif, Jim Gregory, Bill Wernimont, and Bob Masiak.

Bob Masiak called the meeting to order at 5:04 PM.

Minutes from Prior Meetings: Minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved from the meeting on 4/7/2026.

Chief's Reports:

- **Police**

- Continue to explore options for a new police department building. Looked at the vacant Essity building but it has been decided that it is too large. Now leaning toward a new building. There will be a workshop on July 27 to develop plans. Tentative milestone dates are to start construction in Spring 2027 and move in Spring 2028.
- Detective Gustafson has resigned to take a position with the DCI. Interviews for a replacement will take place over the next few weeks.
- Exploring having a sergeant position in the Investigations Department
- Nicholas Thorn started as a patrol officer.
- Chris Brandt was sworn in as a Lieutenant.
- Scott Farrell has moved to days as the Administrative Lieutenant.
- Two retirements are expected in January 2027
- There have been no public inquiries about Flock camera use in Fox Crossing

- **Fire:**

- The 5-year accreditation process is mostly complete. On August 20th, key members of the Fox Crossing Fire Department and Village Board will be in Chicago to meet with the review commission.
- The new sound systems for the stations will be installed in August
- Pursuing a new rescue truck. Expect to order in summer of 2027.

- Staffing levels: full for part-time and down nine positions for paid on-call at station 41.
- Exploring the development of an operational agreement with Gold Cross ambulance. Intent would be to protect level of service and response times.

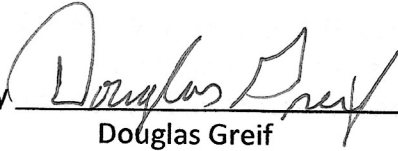
New Business:
