Voter Registration

Proof of Residence Required

Through Wednesday, October 14th, you can register:

- ☆ **Online** at MyVote.wi.gov
- ☆ **In-Person** at the Clerk's Office
- ☆ **Mail** in Voter Registration Application & Proof of Residence to:

Thursday, October 15th – Friday, October 30th at 5:00 p.m.:

- ☆ **In-Person ONLY** at the Clerk's Office *(No registration allowed on Saturday, Sunday, or Monday preceding the Election)*

Election Day you must register at your Polling Place!

Requesting an Absentee Ballot

Govt. Issued Photo ID Required

Through Friday, October 30th, at 5:00 p.m. you may request an absentee ballot:

- ☆ **Online** at MyVote.wi.gov *(Online deadline for Regular & Overseas voters is October 29th at 5:00 p.m.)*
- ☆ **In-Person** at the Clerk's Office *(In-Person Submission Beginning October 20, 2026)*
- ☆ **Mail** in Absentee Ballot Application & a copy of your Govt. Issued Photo ID to:

(Mail deadline for Regular & Overseas voters is October 29th at 5:00 p.m.)

Returning an Absentee Ballot

Absentee Ballots can be returned by the Voter only

Before Election Day:

- ☆ **Mail** in Absentee Ballot via USPS. **Must arrive by or on Election Day.**
- ☆ **In-Person** at the Clerk's Office, hand-delivered by the Voter only
- ☆ **Dropbox** located at the Municipal Complex near the front entrance, by the Voter only

On Election Day:

- ☆ **In-Person** at Central Count location below, hand-delivered by the Voter only

Early In-Person Absentee Voting at Fox Crossing Municipal Complex

Govt. Issued Photo ID Required

(Monday through Friday)

Tuesday, October 20th – Thursday, October 29th 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Friday, October 30th 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

(No in-person absentee voting on Saturday, Sunday, or Monday preceding the Election)
